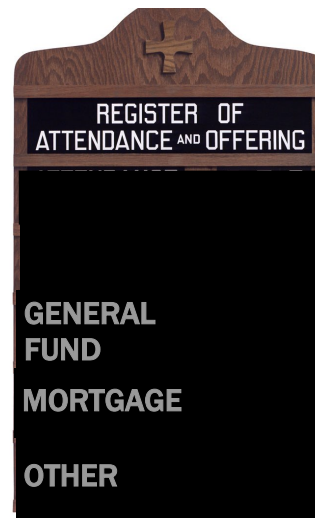

In Nov. 2019, Kimball used \$331,884.64 of its invested funds to pay-off its bank loan, create a facility management reserve, and to balance its operating budget. In September of 2020 an additional \$114,500 was borrowed to purchase the corner lot property as approved by the congregation. In December of 2020 we repaid \$8,591.56 to our investment account bringing our total repayment for the year to \$77,541.40. Also in December we received a grant from the Cannon Charitable Trust for \$40,000 which will further reduce our total remaining amount to be repaid (including the land purchase) to \$342,448.04.
