



IN OUR EFFORTS TO FOLLOW the updated recommendations of the North Carolina Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA), here is the latest guidance from our Synod Council and Bishop about gatherings at Kimball Memorial Lutheran Church.

As a result of the Covid-19 transmission/hospitalization rates in Cabarrus and Rowan Counties (and most of NC), **we are now recommending all worship attendees wear masks, regardless of vaccination status.** Masks are available from ushers at both worship services. At this point, we will not be practicing contact tracing or physical distancing in our worship services, but these procedures will be evaluated each week, with guidance from our Synod. We will continue to have a nursery provided each Sunday morning for both worship services. Those who are keeping our nursery have been vaccinated. Other activities scheduled to begin after Labor Day (Sunday School, Youth Group Meetings, Wednesday Programs, etc) are still planned - although these too will be evaluated based on recommendations from the North Carolina Synod. For the ELCA, the Biblical question, *"Who are the least of these and those most vulnerable?"* has been central to the recommendations of the Synod and our Bishop. Currently, those who are at greatest risk are children who are not yet able to be vaccinated, and those who are unvaccinated for any reason. We ask for your patience as we strive to follow Synod guidance and do what is in the best interest of all our members and friends. We continue to pray for transmissions to decline, for vaccination rates to increase, for all those who are ill from this virus, and for the Covid-19 season to pass. **Lord, in your mercy...Hear our Prayer.**

A "REFORMATION REDUCTION" special offering will be held on Reformation Sunday - October 31st - to put us well on the road to completing our process of "paying ourselves" back fully within the next several months. ELECTRONIC GIVING OPTIONS

Kimball provides a number of different options for our congregation to electronically present their offerings to the church.

ACH Transfer – Individuals can work with their individual bank to set up automated transfers from a selected account to Kimball’s checking account at Wells Fargo. These transfers can be scheduled to occur at whatever frequency and amount the individual desires.

Bill Pay – Most banks today offer a bill payment service with re-occurring feature. Individuals can set up their offering as a bill, and a check will be issued from that account and mailed to Kimball. The frequency of the check issuance and the amount of the check is determined by the individual and is easily changed.

Tithe.ly (thru kimballchurch.org) – By going to our church website, individuals can present offerings thru an electronic service provided by Tithe.ly. The offerings can be set up as a one-time event or as re-occurring. There is a charge for this service and the individual has the option of paying the charge, or the amount will be deducted from the offering when sent to Kimball.

Electronic offerings set up by our previous provider, Vanco, will remain in place and the change to Tithe.ly will have no impact on these items. If you would like any more information about any of these options, or assistance in getting one of the options set up how to get them set up, please contact any member of the finance team, or the church office.

The church office will continue to close at noon on Fridays. We will update the congregation when there is a change.

In November of 2019, Kimball used \$331,884.64 of its invested funds to pay-off our mortgage, create a facility management reserve, and balance our operating budget. In September of 2021, we repaid to ourselves a total of \$68,765 bringing our total repayment to date to \$243,383 dollars and a repayment balance owing of \$88,501.
