



FOLLOWING THE LEAD of our Synod Council and Bishop, and listening closely to the recommendations of our "Start-up Committee", Kimball Memorial will return to two indoor services in our beautiful sanctuary, NEXT Sunday, October 25 - Reformation Sunday. Our limits for these two morning worship opportunities - at 8:30 and 11:00 - will be 60 per service. Sign-ups for these services will continue to open each Wednesday at 10:00 AM, using Sign-Up Genius. The wearing of masks at both of these services will be absolutely essential, as will following the guidelines of social distancing, hand washing, etc. Cleaning will be done by our Janitorial Service on Saturday afternoons, to insure that the sanctuary is clean and safe as we begin worship each Sunday morning, AND volunteers will clean the sanctuary between worship services on Sunday mornings. Please note that we will NOT be returning to congregational singing at this time, nor will we be offering a nursery - both of these decisions being made due to health and safety concerns. You should also know that if a spike in the Corona Virus should take place in North Carolina, the Synod Council may recommend the lowering of attendance guidelines, and that Kimball Church is committed to following the guidelines put forth by our North Carolina Synod leadership. In Nov. 2019, Kimball used \$331,884.64 of its invested funds to pay-off its bank loan, create a facility management reserve, and balance its operating budget. In August & early September of this year a total of \$20,348 of those borrowed funds were repaid to the investment account leaving a repayment balance of \$279,159.80.
