

CONGREGATIONAL MEETINGS have been set for November 27th and December 11th at 10:00 AM. At the November 27th meeting, a roster of candidates for Church Council will be submitted, and the floor will be opened for additional nominations. Copies of the proposed 2023 Budget will be distributed for review. We will also receive a copy of by-laws for the proposed Columbarium for Kimball Memorial, and a prepared overview of the Columbarium - most notably a Question/Answer portion - which we hope will answer any inquiries members/friends may have about this proposed project for the church. On December 11th, voting will take place for the election of new council members and for the 2023 budget. We will also vote on proceeding with the Columbarium, and we will hear a report from the Endowment Team. Please attend these two important meetings.
