In Nov. 2019, Kimball used \$331,884.64 of its invested funds to pay-off its bank loan, create a facility management reserve, and balance its operating budget. In August & early September of this year a total of \$20,348 of those borrowed funds were repaid to the investment account leaving a repayment balance of \$279,159.80.
